# Developments for Release on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> January 2016

#### <u>Security Update – 1<sup>st</sup> December 2015</u> - Internet Browsers

The message was posted to give advanced notice to all users who do not have the TLS v1.1 and TLS v1.2 protocols enabled in their web browsers by default. The TLS1.0 protocol has been disabled in BSP*link* since 1<sup>st</sup> December.

**Integration Phase**: The BSP*link* application will also be accessible through IATA's Customer Portal via "Single Sign On".

Additionally, WebServices will be implemented to manage users' account information and keep both IATA's Customer Portal and BSP*link* synchronised.

A new push functionality will be added for Agent users in order to deliver specific selected files.
