DISH 22.0

On 1st June 2015, based on the implementation schedule set by IATA, the following BSPs have switched to DISH version 22 and as a result, all transactions are reported and files are generated in the new format:

BR, CA, DE, DK, EE, GB, IS, LT, LV, MX, NO, RU, SA and SE.

Future roll out to the following BSPs:

 $\mathbf{29}^{\text{th}}$ June 2015 : AU $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ July 2015 : IN and Southern Africa (BW, MW, MZ, ZA, ZM, ZW).

BSPlink Integration with IATA's Customer Portal

Preparation phase: the BSP*link* application will be modified to permit the collection of users' email addresses which will be used at a later stage by IATA's Portal Team to create Portal Users. To this end, BSP*link* users will be asked to provide and validate an email address upon logging into BSP*link*. This email will be stored and linked to that particular BSP*link* user.

Future Development

Fare Calculation Mode Indicator (FCMI) on Related Document for ADMs

When a related document is available in BSP*link*, the BSP*link* application will auto-populate the corresponding FCMI field for those related documents in the ADM. If one or more related documents do not exist in BSP*link* or are no longer available, the corresponding FCMI will be reported as blank.
