ADM Module Alignment with Resolution 850m - Part 1 & 2

In order to continue the alignment of BSPlink with Resolution 850m, the Contact Information Record (IT0I) in the ADM/ACM mass upload files is mandatory as of <u>October 1st 2012</u>. From this date onwards all transactions with missing contact information in the ACNA (Airline Contact Name), ACPH (Airline Phone/Fax Number) and ACEM (Airline E-Mail Address) fields will be rejected.
