Security Update

1st December 2015 - Internet Browsers

The message was posted to give advanced notice to all users who do not have the TLS v1.1 and TLS v1.2 protocols enabled in their web browsers by default. The TLS1.0 protocol has been disabled in BSPlink since 1st December.

Refunds Process

The lifespan of Refund Applications in the BSPlink system will be modified from 13 to 24 months.

New BSP Setup and WEblink Data Feed

A new environment with ISO Country Code 'XC' will be created in order to process Weblink input DISH RET files, including sales from bookings made by TIDS agents. In addition, Weblink will process Weblink input DISH RET files (Weblink single and multi-country files) including IATA Accredited Agents and TIDS Agents sales and will segregate TIDS agents transactions. All sales corresponding to those agents will be processed and reported in a Weblink output RET file with ISO Country 'XC'.
